Individual Pleads Guilty to Theft of iPads from Virginia State Senators

RICHMOND, VA –On January 9, 2013, Mr. Tyrone Darrick Thomas pled guilty to grand larceny involving the theft of 4 iPads from Senators' offices in the General Assembly Building in March, 2012. He was sentenced to 5 years suspended, and ordered to pay \$650 in restitution. All of the stolen iPads were recovered.

On June 30th, 2012, the Division of Capitol Police, with the assistance of Richmond City Police, executed search warrants at residences on Terminal Avenue and Garland Avenue in connection with the theft of iPads that had been reported stolen this past March from Senators' offices in the General Assembly Building in Richmond. Mr. Tyrone Darrick Thomas was arrested and charged with three felony counts of grand larceny.
